

Shelter-In-Place Instructions

What should I do?

Shelter

To Shelter-In-Place if there is a chemical odor or other sign of possible exposure: Go inside your home, office or other building. Bring in your pets if you think appropriate. A pre-selected interior room with no or few windows is the best location.

Close

Close all exterior windows and doors. Locking the windows may provide a tighter seal. Tape or seal cracks or openings to around doors or windows to provide even more protection. Damp towels can be placed below closed doors to provide a better seal.

Close or turn off anything that might bring air in from the outside. Examples are heating and air conditioning systems, fireplace dampers, vents, range fans, bathroom fans and clothes dryers.

Listen for Instruction

Wait for information and further instructions from Emergency Officials or through **Ready Kern**. Do not use the telephone unless you have an emergency.

Listen for an “All Clear” alarm from the Refinery (a single horn blast of 15 seconds).

After an “All Clear” notification, if you do not detect any odors or smoke outside, you can use fans to move fresh air through your home.
